**P:** Welcome to the celebration of our Lord's ascension into heaven. We worship our risen and ascended Lord in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

**Glory be to the Father and to the Son

**P:** God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

**ALL:** **Almighty God, merciful Father, we are sinful by nature, and we have sinned against You in our thoughts, words, and actions. Forgive us for Jesus' sake, renew us by Your Spirit, and lead us in the way everlasting. Amen.**

**P:** Jesus Christ is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. God has accepted the sacrifice of His Son and welcomed Him to His right hand in heaven. With boldness and confidence we may approach the throne to find grace to help in time of need. In the peace of forgiveness, let us praise the Lord!

## A Harmony of the Ascension Accounts

Jesus presented Himself alive after His suffering to the apostles He had chosen by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father. "Behold, I send the promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high. For John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?"

And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. Now it came to pass, while He blessed them, that He was parted from them and carried up into heaven. While they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. And they worshiped Him.

And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

Then with great joy they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey. They were continually in the temple praising and blessing God.

And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that would be written. And after the Holy Spirit was poured out on them, His disciples went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

## Sermon

**Ephesians 4:7-16** - But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. 8 Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." 9 (Now this, "He ascended" -- what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) 11 And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; 14 that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, 15 but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head -- Christ -- 16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.
